Description

This double-sided tape consists of a paper tissue carrier, layered on both sides with a modified solvent acrylate adhesive. It has a very good resistance to UV radiation, extreme temperatures, chemicals, solvents and humidity. Its highly shear-resistant adhesive has an excellent durability when attached to metal, varnish and high energy surfaces. Because of its high adhesive mass it is also appropriate for rough or structured surfaces.
